St. Thomas More School offers a variety of opportunities to participate in competitive athletics. The school year begins with boys football and girls basketball. At the conclusion of these seasons, boys basketball and girls volleyball are offered. Finally, in the Spring semester, track and field is offered for both boys and girls. The track season is very short and is offered to allow students to participate and determine whether this is a sport they will pursue in high school. Teams in all but track are determined after try-outs. The coaches of the teams are responsible for evaluating and choosing the team members. After CSAA teams are chosen, remaining players will have an opportunity to compete in the CSAA JV league provided coaches and players are available.
