STM Summer Camp 2018

General Information

May 29th- July 27th

Monday- Friday

The campers may be dropped off no earlier than 7:00 am, and may be picked up no later than 5:45 pm. **Any camper picked up after 5:45 pm will be charged \$1 per minute per child.**

Lunch/Snack

The students must bring a lunch every day, and snacks are highly recommended. There will be a morning snack time and an evening snack time during which the students may eat snacks and enjoy drinks brought from home. We have three microwaves that may be used with a counselor's assistance. We just ask that anything being microwaved take less than a minute and a half, and comes with all necessary plates or bowls.

Events

We are currently in the process of booking our fun-filled trips. Bowling at Circle Bowl, jumping around at Party Playground, swimming, eating sno-cones, and watching movies are some of the entertainment we enjoy throughout the summer.

One day a week we will have "snacks at camp," and one day we will enjoy arts and crafts.

A few things that have not been confirmed as of yet are entertainers visiting us at camp and a few other trips. Our goal is to go on at least three trips a week, weather permitting.

An Average Day at Camp

The students will arrive at camp in the cafeteria where they will sign in with an adult counselor, and then hang out with other St. Thomas More students. There will be a Kinect/ Lego station for the young builders, a baby doll/play house station for those creative imaginations, and an array of board/card games of different levels. Once the majority of the campers have arrived the campers will gather in an age appropriate group to eat snack, and say a morning prayer.

After morning snack, some days we will go to the gym to play organized games and on others we may go to the playground. The campers will then take part in the scheduled activity or board a bus to have a blast on a field trip. When we return the campers will have an opportunity to buy a piece of candy for \$1.00 that they may eat as we watch a movie in the extended care room while sitting on bean bags. At this time our campers may also choose to read their summer reading books or do summer workbooks. We will then eat an afternoon snack and play games as they are being picked up. Summer camp closes at 5:45 each evening.

Behavior

All campers and parents are expected to respect the camp counselors at all times. Behaviors negatively affecting the enjoyment of a campers including, but not limited to: physical altercations, inappropriate language, disrespect, or a lack of cooperation with the counselors may be cause for dismissal from the summer camp program without a refund.

**VBS and other STM Summer Programs are separate from summer camp. They will be offered to all children attending summer camp by enrolling and paying to do so. Due to insurance purposes, you will be responsible for any transportation for your child from VBS to the summer camp field trips.*
